DIGITAL IMAGES GUIDELINES

- 1. Digital images should be sent as .jpg, .tif (tiff), or pdf format.
- 2. Send digital images through email as an attachment, NOT embedded in anothe document such as Microsoft Word.
- 3. Color pictures are preferred with no prior image adjustments or cropping.
- 4. Digital images should be scanned at 1200 dpi for bitmap art; 300 dpi for photographs; OR at least 75 percent of its original size.
- 5. As a guideline, digital image files should be at least 1MB in size.

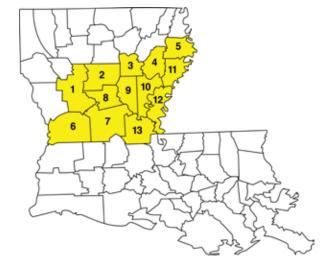
