Two rooms have twin-sized beds which are wheelchair accessible and have tubs in bathrooms.</p> <p>Building 300 has 23 rooms, each has two, extra-long twin-sized beds with private bath. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANUP: Guest rooms have departure instructions which include wiping down the bathroom fixtures and vacuuming (vacuums provided). If additional cleaning is required after your departure, janitorial services will be billed to you. We can recommend janitorial services if you are unable to perform cleanup.

STRICTLY PROHIBITED:

1. The use of nails, staples, tacks, or other item of this nature which is used for affixing or hanging materials on any walls/ceilings (including ceiling grid) is strictly prohibited without the expressed, written consent of Maryhill management. Furthermore, only blue painter's tape is allowed. However, the placement of this tape must be approved by Maryhill management prior to the use of the facility. Lastly, the covering of any window on the campus with any material whatsoever is prohibited without the expressed, written consent of Maryhill management. Violations of this policy may result in additional charges to the contracted user for repair costs.

2. The use of Amplified audio/music; audio speakers are strictly prohibited OUTDOORS. The use of sound equipment is allowed. Please keep amplification sounds indoors in consideration for others who may be using the Maryhill Facilities at the same time.
